THE KEY TO SENDING GOOD CODE IS TO MAKE SURE DITS AND DAHS ARE EASILY DISTINGUISHED FROM ONE ANOTHER IF SENDING WITH A HANDKEY OR BUG ONE MAY END UP MAKING DAHS THAT SOUND TOO SIMILAR TO DITS THAT IS A PROBLEM BECAUSE THE SOUND PATTERNS OF DIFFERENT CHARACTERS BECOMES HARDER TO DISTILL IN ADDITION IT IS IMPORTANT TO KEEP PROPER SPACING BETWEEN CHARACTERS AND WORDS A KEYER MAY HELP TO SEND DISTINCT DITS AND DAHS BUT SPACING IS UP TO THE USER
