

MANY RADIOS WITH BUILT-IN KEYERS AND EXTERNAL KEYERS ALLOW USERS TO ADJUST THE RELATIVE DURATION OF DAHS VERSUS DITS MOST HAMS SEEM TO PREFER A 3 TO 1 RATIO WHICH MAKES IT RELATIVELY EASY TO HEAR THE DIFFERENCE WHEN LISTENING TO CHARACTER SOUND PATTERNS IF YOU SHORTEN THE RATIO, DAHS BEGIN TO SOUND MORE LIKE DITS AND BECOME HARDER TO DISCERN IF YOU LENGTHEN THE RATIO DAHS MAY BE A BIT MORE DISCERNIBLE BUT THE OVERALL CHARACTER SOUNDS MAY SOUND DISTORTED IT IS A JUDGMENT CALL AND MOST HAMS KEEP THE RATIO AT 3 TO 1 SPACING IS EVERYTHING
